

APRIL 6TH & 7TH ALAMO LAKE

Rules of the Tournament

1. The Tournament Committee will register a maximum of 100 teams for entry into the tournament.

Priority registration will be granted to Professional Fire Fighters of Arizona and corporate sponsors until March 15th. To receive priority registration, at least one fisherman must be a member in good standing with the Professional Fire Fighters of Arizona. After March 15th, applications will be accepted from the general public on a first come first serve basis.
2. Only two (2) fishermen per boat.
3. A maximum of five (5) fish per team will weigh in per day. Bass caught on the first day of the tournament cannot be weighed in on the second day of the tournament.
4. All fish must be alive for weigh in. There will be a ½ pound penalty for each dead fish. All fish will be returned to the lake after weigh-in.
5. The Tournament Committee will settle conflicts regarding weight and measurements of a fish or stinger of fish.
6. Live well check at 5:00 a.m. both days. Weigh-in will be at 5:00 p.m. on the 6th and 12:00 noon on the 7th.
7. The tournament headquarters will be in the group use area with weigh-in station at Cholla ramp.
8. Life jackets will be worn anytime the boat motor is running.
9. **All Arizona Game and Fish regulations will be adhered to. Any legal bait will be acceptable.**
10. Launching order for Tournament will be established by the order that entry fees are received.
11. **Slot limit is 13 – 16 inches.**
